Ali lost his father to Covid-19 during the pandemic, leaving his mother to care for him and his 3 siblings. The family is living below the poverty line, with their late father's pension now their only income.

As a result of a car accident 5 years ago, Ali is in need of a cranial implant but has yet to receive the necessary treatment due to their financial situation. He and his siblings attend a local school while also being supported by the Library.
